Trail Map

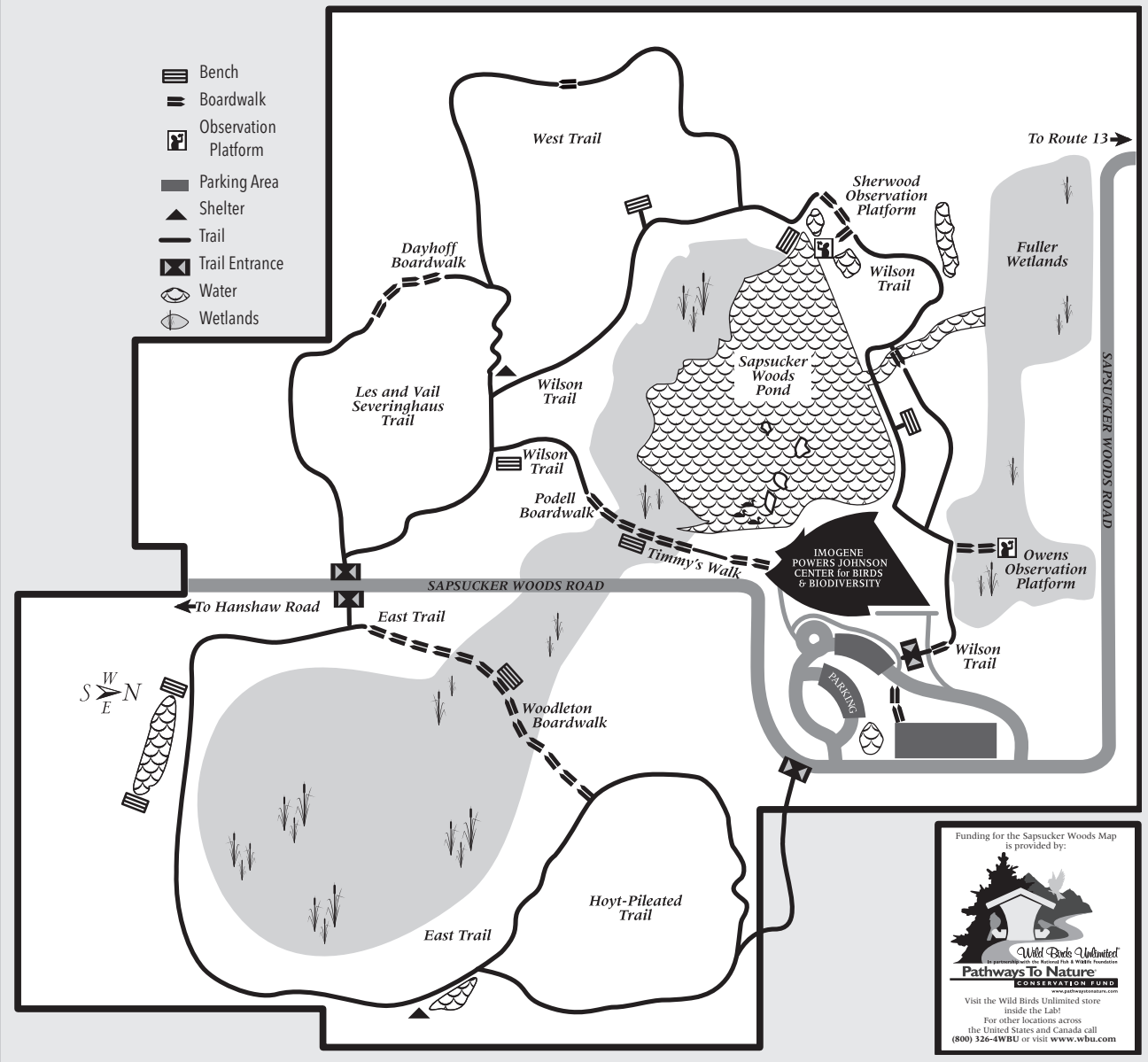
ENJOY YOUR HIKE, AND PLEASE
