

## How to Install the Drip Tray in a SwiftOne

The drip tray is crucial for catching any battery acid leaks, preventing them from damaging the main board of the device.

### Tools and Materials Needed:

- Small Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Drip Tray

#### 1. Locate the Installation Points:

- Identify the two existing screws where the drip tray will be installed.



#### 2. Remove Existing Screws:

- Use the Phillips head screwdriver to remove the screws and associated toothed washers from the device.

#### 3. Align the Drip Tray:

- Place the drip tray so that its holes align with the screw holes on the device.
- You may find that placing the washers and screws in the tray's holes first is helpful to keep them in place during installation



#### 4. Secure the Drip Tray:

- Use the Phillips head screwdriver to tighten the screws and washers down, securing the drip tray in place. *Note: If you have an older Swift, the tray may tilt up slightly because of the placement of a few brackets.*
